SHARE THE LOVE! BUY YOUR PUB

We are overwhelmed by the support of the community so far. At the time of writing, we have already raised £172,000 – but we still need your help to achieve our minimum £230,000 target.

Our MP, Alicia Kearns, has visited the Parish to hear about the project and is providing her full support; as are our County, Borough and Parish Councillors.

The Share Issue closes on Friday 26 August, so please take some time to complete a Share Application form and become part of this monumental community project to enable us to purchase the pub for this and future generations. If you have already made a share application you can increase it, as long as the total does not exceed the maximum. All household members, as long as they are 18 years of age, can become members. The more the merrier!

Every little helps. We value every share investor - whether you purchase the minimum £50 or the maximum £20,000. Remember that as a Community Benefit Society it is One Member, One Vote – we are all equal.

Just because The Black Horse sits in Grimston village centre does not mean that it is only for this small village – it is an asset for the whole parish, surrounding villages and rural area, and the much wider community. The definition of community, as far as us and funders are concerned, includes a national and international perspective, not just a narrow immediate village interpretation. **If you are reading this – The Black Horse is for you!**

As our original prospective tenant has withdrawn, we are actively working with the pub owners to find a suitable replacement.
