We will be using professionals to carry out the roof ridges, porch slates and lead flashing, chimney cowls and external elevation work and painting. We have various other jobs being undertaken by volunteers but the list below is a range of tasks that need doing and we would welcome support for the following. Some can be started now, others will follow on from a previous task:

- Rehanging the internal doors (most in the flat and some others do not close)
- Clean down and paint the garage door
- Clean down and paint (Hammerite) the side entrance gates
- Sand and teak oil patio furniture
- Sand down and renovate childrens' picnic bench
- Clean and check reservoir and water pump for water feature
- Cleaning upstairs flat
- Painting upstairs flat
- Stripping woodchip wallpaper in the trading area
- Cleaning and painting the underground cellar
- Cleaning old boiler room, trading and bar areas
- Petanque pitch renovation
- Painting kitchen and part of kitchen floor (after professional deep clean)
